REEF TOUR 2012 FAQ'S

Q: What is a "Reef Tour"?

A: The Annual WMAS Reef Tour is basically a group "Open House" where Club Members open their homes to the general public for the purpose of showcasing their aquarium systems. This is a "family friendly" Club Event. The purpose of the Reef Tour is to promote the hobby as well as give back to the community at large, by providing a source of information and viewing pleasure for those who may not currently be involved in the hobby, or those who just want to learn more about the fine art of Marine Reef keeping. It is your option to visit as many of the Reef Tour homes as you want; some people just visit those close to their own neighborhood – others try to stop at every house on the Tour.

Q: Does it cost anything to attend the Reef Tour?

A: No - absolutely not. This is a 100% FREE Event, sponsored by the Wasatch Marine Aquarium Society. There is no cost whatsoever – and EVERYONE is welcome, including children accompanied by a parent or guardian. You do NOT have to be a Member of WMAS to attend.

Q: What kinds of aquariums will I see on the Reef Tour?

A: You will see a wide variety of aquariums and Reef systems; the Reef Tour will feature "Nano" systems as small as 5 or 10 gallons, all the way up to 300+ gallon monster show tanks. Some of these aquarium setups will be relatively new (maybe 3 – 6 months old); some have been up and running for close to a decade... all owned and managed by Members of WMAS.

Q: Where else in my neighborhood / town / county is there going to be a Reef Tour home?

A: On the WMAS website (<u>www.utahreefs.com</u>) there is a downloadable / printable Online Tour Guide booklet that lists ALL the Reef Tour host homes - along with a map and directions to each home, and description of their aquarium(s) - even a picture or 2 of the featured aquarium(s).
